## How To Teach



### Overview

Lessons will go much more smoothly if you prepare thoroughly. As students gain experience, develop fine motor skills, and practice habits of precision they will need less support.



### Prepare

Watch video tutorials or make the model yourself. Gather supplies and materials needed.



### Recap

Connect back to previous lesson and skills learned.



### Read

Read the instructions one step at a time. Model each step and make sure students complete it with precision before moving to the next step.



### Practice

When a project is complete, students may repeat it as many times as they wish to give as gifts or create original patterns similar to the project.



## Term 1

### WEEK 1 **30m Sloyd: Level 5 - Lesson 1**

#### *Cardboard Work Model 1 Cube*

Materials: Sloyd by Schwartz, paper, chipboard, ruler, pencil, scissors, tape, awl, bone (optional), X-Acto knife, compass

#### → READ

Read Part II. Card-board Work on p.27-29 to get a short overview of expectations for level 5 Sloyd. The concepts are the same as paper sloyd in earlier levels, though the problems to solve become slightly more challenging, as does the media used to build the models. Watch the tutorial to understand how the lessons should work.
